



## The Pterosaur Database

### Boreopterus cuiae

A near complete skeleton including the skull, found in the early Cretaceous deposits of Liaoning Province, China. This specimen has a large number of teeth which are significantly larger than many Ornithocheirids. The anterior nine pairs of teeth are the largest.



**Holotype:** JZMP-04-07-3  
Skull and most of the post cranial skeleton
