



Eoazhdarcho liaoxiensis

A partial skeleton and lower jaw from Chaoyang, Liaoning Province, China. The specimen is of Aptian age from the Jiufotang Formation of the Jehol Group of Lower Cretaceous Sediments. (Lü & Ji, 2005)

Abstract: A nearly complete skeleton with a lower jaw, from the Early Cretaceous of western Liaoning is described and assigned to a new genus. *Eoazhdarcho* gen. nov. .. The new genus is characterized by a relatively small size. the ratio of the length to width of the middle series cervical vertebrae and approximately 3.5 the ratio of length to femoral length constituted approximately 0.96. The humerus of *Eoazhdarcho* shows similarities with that of previously described *Azhdarchidae*, so it is assigned to this family.
