

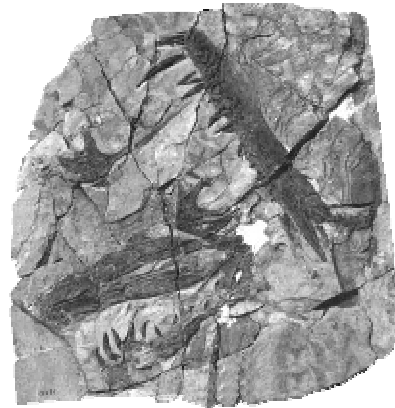


The Pterosaur Database

Liaoningopterus gui

This is the largest pterosaur to be found in China. It also displays the largest teeth seen in a pterosaur. The fossil was found in the Jiufotang Formation of Chaoyang, Liaoning, China and it is of Barremian-Aptian age.
