



## The Pterosaur Database

### Noripterus parvus

Small Dsungaripterid from the lower cretaceous of the Zagan Zabsk formation of Western Mongolia with a skull length of 20cm.

Originally named *Phobetor parvus*, this specimen is a junior synonym of *Noripterus*. The name *Phobetor* is already in use for a species of scorpioniform fish.
