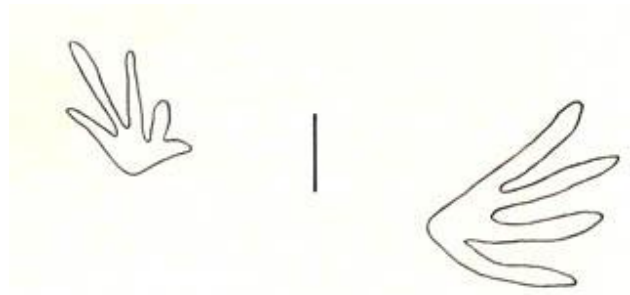




Antipus Flexiloquus
