



## The Pterosaur Database

### Campylognathoides liassicus

Several well preserve specimens have been recovered from the Posidonian Shale and sediments of the Upper Lias in Bavaria, Germany. This pterosaur has an average wingspan of 1 metre. In 1986 a complete pelvis was found with hip sockets intact.

**Holotype:** Institute of Geology and Paleontology, University of Tübingen, Germany.
