



## The Pterosaur Database

### Bogolubovia orientalis

This pterosaur was first described from a single vertebra by Niklai Nikolaevich Bogolubov, the Russian palaeontologist in 1914. It was originally called *Ornithostoma orientale* and was discovered in the Upper Cretaceous strata near Petrowsk, Russia. The name was re-assigned by Nesson and Yarkov in 1989.
