Ctenochasma gracile

One complete specimen and six partial specimens are known from the Solnhofen limestone of Bavaria, Germany. These include the fine skull and the jaw shown below.



Holotype: BSP-AS-Vi-30 Part and counterpart showing a partial skull (Opper, 1862)

Referred Specimen: BSP-1935-i-24 Almost complete skeleton. (Broili, 1936)
