Plataleorhynchus streptophorodon

Fossil of a pterosaur snout with a terminal spatulate shape. Rostrum in palatal aspect. Teeth are laterally positioned around the snout. Purbeck Limestone, Dorset, England. Probably Tethonian, Upper Jurassic in age, but this specimen may be just into the Berriasian of the Lower Cretaceous.
