**Abstract:** The Cameros Basin in the Iberian Mountain range (NE of Spain) is very rich in ichnites of dinosaurs and other vertebrates of the Lower Cretaceous. Serrantes site nearby Villar del Río, are studied, all of them belonging to Tischer's (1966) Oncala Group (Tithonian?-Berriasian). The palaeontologic site at Serrantes has an extensive set of dinosaurs, birds, crocodiles and pterosaurs prints. The prints which are described in present note can be classified as *Pteraichnus* and provided the new ichnospecies *Pteraichnus longipodus*.
