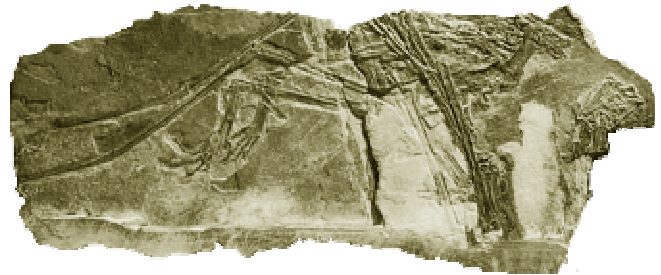

1797 Type specimen - partial skeleton with missing hind quarters and part skull.

1922 Humerus, thoracic vertebrae, ribs, wing phalange, incomplete lower jaw and traces of patagium.

21545 Disarticulated skeleton, jaw, skull bones, vertebrae, ribs and elements of the pectoral and pelvic girdles.
