



Eudimorphodon species

Eudimorphodon sp. (cf. ranzii)

Disarticulated specimen from the Seefelder Schischen of Austria, probable Alanian in age. This specimen includes teeth, jugal, two partial lower jaws, vertebrae, ribs, sternum, scapulo-caracoid, humerus, first wing phalange, tibia and fibula.
